

A new research study co-authored by Senior Project Associate Donald Harris, MBA, examined suicide prevention-focused PSAs shared on YouTube and the resulting comments to identify relationships between the message's frame and format and the subsequent level of help-seeking language used in the comments. Mr. Harris and his co-author found that PSAs using a gain-focused frame and narrative format were more likely to receive positive comments. Narrative-formatted PSAs were

more likely to receive comments using help-seeking language.






