

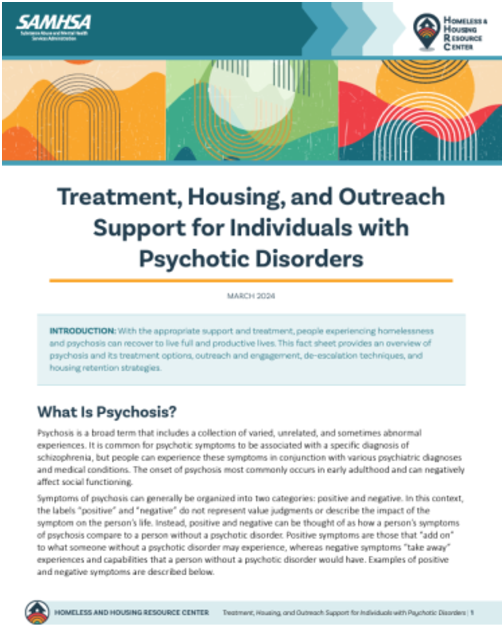


New Fact Sheet on Treatment, Housing, and Outreach Support for Individuals With Psychotic Disorders

The Homeless and Housing Resource Center (HHRC), operated by Policy Research, has released a new fact sheet, "Treatment, Housing, and Outreach Support for Individuals With Psychotic Disorders." This 11-page resource provides an overview of psychosis and its treatment options. It presents outreach, engagement, and support strategies for people with psychotic symptoms to achieve and maintain housing. The publication provides guidance, related resources for more information, and examples on how to put recommended strategies into practice.

This fact sheet complements information shared in two recent HHRC webinars, "[Introduction to Psychotic Disorders](#)" (May 2023) and "[Outreach and Housing Support for Individuals With Psychotic Disorders](#)" (June 2023). These three resources can serve as a strong foundation for homelessness service providers who have limited experience in working with people diagnosed with psychotic disorders.
